December 1: Scholarship and Housing Application Opens for Admitted Students.

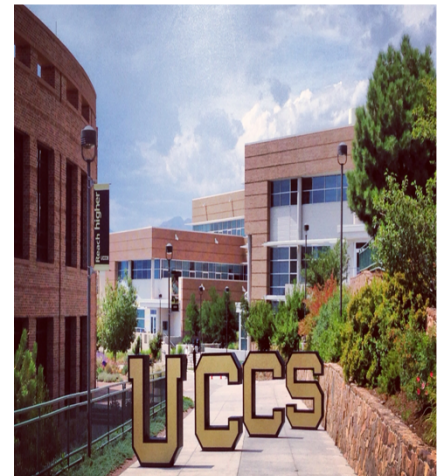
February 1: Early Scholarship Deadline.

## **Keep in Mind**

- **Fall 2020 Application** is open! Our Peak Performance Application is non-binding and students are required to pay the \$50 application fee unless they qualify for a [NACAC fee waiver](#).
- **Admissions Decisions** take place 2-3 weeks after we have received all the application materials.
- **Transcripts** can take up to one week to be uploaded and attached to an application. Students may receive an email stating that we have not received their transcript. Please only resend transcripts if it has been over two weeks.
- **Email Documents** to your admissions counselor such as a pdf version of the high school transcript, NACAC fee waiver, and ACT or SAT score report.
- **Super Score**-UCCS super scores ACT or SAT scores. Test scores on the high school transcript are considered official.
- **Application Status Checks**-Email your [Admissions Counselor](#) to check on the status of your student's application.
